Floyd County now has its own permanent Household Hazardous Waste facility. The new facility is located at 37 W. 8th Street, just below Main Street. It is open every Friday, by appointment (948-4733). This service is designed to take the place of previously held Tox-Away Days, which were only held once a year. The following is a list of some of the more common materials accepted at the new facility:

- Flammables:
- Used motor oil
 - Gasoline
 - Transmission fluid
 - Other automotive fluids
 - Aerosol cans
 - Adhesives
 - Paint thinners



- Paints:
- Oil based paints

- Batteries
- Automotive batteries
 - Motorcycle batteries
 - Cell phone batteries
 - Rechargeable batteries



- Electronics:
- Computers, monitors, printers
 - VCR's, stereos

- Others:
- Used antifreeze
 - Poisons
 - Fluorescent bulbs
 - Pesticides/herbicides



What is not accepted:

Television sets, asbestos, smoke detectors, ammunition, fireworks, explosives, fire extinguishers, radioactive waste, infectious & biological waste
